CALEB WELCOMES ALBANIA AFFILIATES



Four churches situated in Albania have chosen to join Caleb Ministries, the first from that communism suppressed country since its release from its dictatorship. In 1991, the Socialist Party of Albania, with specific social democratic ideology took control of the country through democratic elections. One year later the Democratic Party of Albania won the new elections. After 1990, Albania has been seeking a closer relationship with the

West. It has been rocked by pyramid schemes, inexperience with democracy or capitalism, or

healthy western investment. The Christian church went underground in 1931. The Republic of Albania is a country in Southeast Europe on the Adriatic and Ionian Sea within the Mediterranean Sea. It shares land borders with Montenegro to the northwest, Kosovo^[] to the northeast, North Macedonia to the east, Greece to the south and a maritime border with Italy to



the west. The Christian Church was driven underground during WWII and now is re-emerging thanks to the Illyricum Movement of Albanian Christians. Emanuel Fresku church has but 7 members. Eklesia Church is reaching young Muslims for Christ. Disciples Church has mostly University students. Sun Hill Church is the nurturing body for the others. Edi and Bona Demo and their family have moved to Albania to bring up the church much as Ken and Linda Stapleton of Chechmate Ministries have done in the Chech Republic.

Frequently Asked for Items:

Caleb Ministry has been asked for the following items by churches and/or villages in the Philippines:

Medications—over-the- counter medications/half used medicines (call Jerry Riess at 206 242 4264 to verify usefulness.(by law, medicatons we send now must not be expired)

Clothing—Linens, cloth, light weight summer clothing, shoes (especially flip-flops), winter clothing, & larger sized clothing. Romania is seeking heavier clothing and donations of food items to minister to the poor in south Serbia.

Baby blankets & quilts

Food—rice, beans, Spam, canned meats of any kind.

Velveeta cheese, canned cocoa, and powdered milk Musical Instruments (small)—accordions, harmonicas, violins, keyboards, etc. Hygiene items=tooth-brushes, travel-sized scented soaps, shampoo .toothpaste, and bandages

Bibles— books on scripture, study Bibles and Biblical texts.

Biblical Text Books and Teaching Materials –any good treatises or devotions, studies and learned materials are welcome.

FOOD ITEMS NEEDED

With the addition of the 2 ft.³ buddy boxes shipped free for us by Atlas Shipping, we have the privilege of providing food items to people in the more remote mountain villages. Because of donations of sacks of white rice, beans, tea, and canned meats, we are complementing the other goods and giving pastors the opportunity to help the more needy families within their small churches. We use about 60 clean coffee tins each month in repackaging these items. Food banks recently have supplied their surplus resources to us including beans, peas, canned fruits and other items.

Letter from the Director:

As many of you know, Caleb pays a licensing fee of over \$100 for each movie we screen for the public in churches. The license permits us to show the feature in churches for one year so long as we do not charge admission. Recently we were given a copy of Dennis Swanberg's standup comedy routine "live refreshed". We contacted his organization to obtain an event license and after they reviewed Caleb ministries websites and newsletters, they gave us permission to show any and all of their DVDs without charge! We fill very blessed by this gift.

For many reasons, we are of necessity cutting back on many of our activities for reasons of health, absence of young volunteers, and mounting expenses in our work. An inventory of supplies on hand indicates it would be prudent to make 5000 candy packs this year rather than the customary 6000. This means each recipient church would receive a box of 200 candy packs rather than 250. As most of the churches are very small and the villages we serve similarly small, we have decided this is a reasonable road to take. Praise the Lord for His provision.
