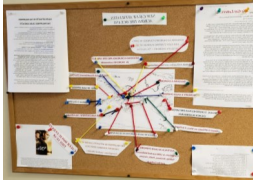

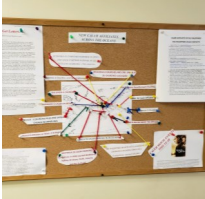

CALEB AFFILIATES ACROSS THE GLOBE

When Caleb Ministry started 30 years ago, the hope was to assist and encourage others across the World to sharpen their understanding of Christ, reach out to others in sharing, and lead more and more to Our Lord. Aside from Evangelism journeys, founding of churches where none were thriving, and helping those suffering from natural or man-made disasters, the fourth plan was and is to openly affiliate with churches and missions throughout the world. Caleb has established geographic districts of West Africa ((94 affiliates located in 28 countries), Eastern Europe (756 churches in 7 countries), Western Europe (18 affiliates in 5 countries), The Philippines



and Asia (86 affiliates comprising 759 churches and 256,000 confessions of faith), Indian Subcontinent (794 affiliates in India, Pakistan, Afghanistan, Nepal and Myamar), Australia and New Zealand with 28 Romanian Style Churches established , and other new Affiliates from Kenya, Tanzania, Ethiopia and East Africa being processed in. Teachings offered freely to the affiliates through Internet and Skype started with 2012 program "Building Saints". Next came the live one-

time program from Maui where students in Maui ministered live to believers in Ghana while affiliates watched live across the globe from Ireland to Bucharest, Dehli to St Petersburg, and Manila to USA. Presently we are processing a new affiliate request a week.

UPCOMING CALEB 12 LESSON TEACHING "NO HOLD"

Daniel will be leading 12 lessons on a "No Holds" strategy to address strategy for maturity, forgiveness, and renovation, to be taught by Skype and by Chrome Google Documents, offered free to all affiliates with live internet feed, starting this spring. Letters of invitation will be issued in the coming weeks for those wishing syllabus and teaching materials for their ministry.

Frequently Asked for Items:

Caleb Ministry has been asked for the following items by churches and/or villages in the Philippines:

Medications—over-the- counter medications/half used medicines (call Jerry Riess at 206 242 4264 to verify usefulness.(by law, medicatons we send now must not be expired)**Clothing**—Linens, cloth, light weight summer clothing, shoes (especially flip-flops), winter clothing, & larger sized clothing. Romania is seeking heavier clothing and donations of food items to minister to the poor in south Serbia.

Baby blankets & quilts

Food—rice, beans, Spam, canned meats of any kind. Velveeta cheese, canned cocoa, and powdered milk

Musical Instruments (small)—accordions, harmonicas, violins, keyboards, etc. **Hygiene items**=tooth-brushes, travel-sized scented soaps, shampoo .toothpaste, and bandages

Bibles— books on scripture, study Bibles and Biblical texts.

Biblical Text Books and Teaching Materials –any good treatises or devotions, studies and learned materials are welcome.

FOOD ITEMS NEEDED

With the addition of the buddy boxes shipped free for us by Atlas Shipping, we have the privilege of providing food items to people in the more remote mountain villages. Because of donations of sacks of white rice, beans, tea, and canned meats, we are complementing the other goods and giving pastors the opportunity to help the more needy families within their small churches. We use about 60 clean coffee tins each month in repackaging these items. Food banks recently have supplied their surplus resources to us including beans, and peas.canned fruits and other items.

OMRON CHURCH PROGRAM NEWS

In 2013, Typhoon Haiyan struck the Philippines with record breaking sustained winds of 230-245 miles per hour, devastating the major city of Tacloban on Leyte Island. A Caleb Team visited four days later, bringing in relief goods as one of the first outside visitors. Leaving Tacloban where many relief efforts were under way, we journeyed to the city of Omron, equally as decimated but mostly overlooked due to its size and remoter location. At Omron, we stayed four nights in the shell of the church of Eric and Cherill Zabala, sleeping on the pews in the evenings, their adjacent house having only two partial walls standing.

Seeing the devastation, we have purposed to help this dedicated Pastor and family rebuild. Caleb has shipped four sewing machines with fabrics, funds and food, and other supplies. Today, we see Pastor Eric sharing our boxes with others! While with his family, we helped Eric rebuild the well, dormitory for seminarians, and his church. His work and that of his wife and children encouraged us to ship more appropriate relief supplies to stricken
