

Frequently Asked for Items:

Caleb has been asked for the following items by churches and/or villages in the Philippines:

Medications—over-the- counter medications/half used medicines (call Jerry Riess at 206 242 4264 to verify usefulness.(by law, medicatons we send now must not be expired)

Clothing—Linens, cloth, light weight summer clothing, shoes (especially flip-flops), winter clothing, & larger sized clothing. Romania is seeking heavier clothing and donations of food items to minister to the poor in south Serbia.

Baby blankets & quilts

Food—rice, beans, Spam, canned meats of any kind. Velveeta cheese, canned cocoa, and powdered milk

Musical Instruments (small)—accordions, harmonicas, violins, keyboards, etc.

Hygiene items=tooth-brushes, travel-sized scented soaps, shampoo .toothpaste, and bandages

FOOD ITEMS NEEDED

With the addition of the 2 ft.³ buddy boxes shipped free for us by Atlas Shipping, we have the privilege of providing food items to people in the more remote mountain villages. Because of donations of sacks of white rice, beans, tea, and canned meats, we are complementing the other goods and giving pastors the opportunity to help the more needy families within their small churches. 546 coffee cans filled with rice has been sent this year

CALEB CELEBRATES 30 YEARS OF SERVICE

We are honored by how much Jesus has permitted this modest ministry to do in 30 years. It is a true miracle that we

have been privileged to successfully ship 135 40-foot high-cube cargo containers to Romania, delivered to villages, churches, gypsy gatherings, Danube refuges and hospital centers,



and another 35 40-foot high-cube cargo containers to other countries, including Nigeria, Kenya, Ghana, South Africa, Australia, The Philippines, Hungary, and Thailand! Our missionary teams visiting the frontiers and presenting Jesus to new audi ences have included Ina Aust, Steven Inkleberger, Phil Duborg, Paul Eklund, Michael Phillips, Pastor Dan Johnson and Jerry Riess. We have helped establish new churches or revitalize underground ministries in Ghana, Benin, Togo, Nigeria, Ethiopia, Kenya, Tanzania, Romania, Hungary, Bulgaria, India, Pakistan, Nepal, Thailand, Indonesia, Australia, and many throughout The Philippines.
